A story is told of a Roman aqueduct at Segovia, Spain. It was built in 109 A.D. For 1800 years, it carried cool water from the mountains to the hot and thirsty city. Nearly 60 generations of men drank from its flow. Then came a new generation, who said, "This aqueduct is so great a marvel that it ought to be preserved for our children, as a museum piece. We shall relieve it of its centuries-long labor."

They did; they laid modern iron pipes. They gave the ancient bricks and mortar a reverent rest. And the aqueduct began to fall apart. The sun beating on the dry mortar caused it to crumble. The bricks and stone sagged and threatened to fall. "What ages of service could not destroy idleness disintegrated."


As we continue our series, *i Truths For An i pod Generation*, the truth we focus on this morning is *i Serve*. The Apostle Paul, in Romans compares the church to a "Body." The human body serves as a great illustration as to the workings, plan and potential of the Church.

There are many Christians who have placed themselves upon the shelf and are now in the same condition as this Roman aqueduct. (dried up and falling apart). As a result of individuals who neglect to serve, many churches have become "museum pieces" and are now irrelevant to the communities they were called to serve.

Paul compares the "Church" to the human body. Our bodies are made up of many Systems. Each of these systems work independently and also work together in order for us to function properly. Paul uses the human body as a grand example of diversity and unity.

It is a humbling thought to realize that we are the body of Christ. A "Casting Crowns" song asks this question:

If we are Christ's body, are His arms reaching? If we are Christ's body, are His hands healing? If we are Christ's body, are His words teaching? If we are Christ's body, are His feet going?

Ekklesia 01/12/2014. When Was establish the Church?

Since our Lord Jesus Christ started his Ministry, His message was: "The time has come," he said. "The kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!" Mark 1:15. Our Lord was talking about the establishment of the earthly part of His Kingdom, The Church. He

of His Kingdom, The Church. He mentioned this to His disciples in *Mark 16:18*, "And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it." But when was the specific moment of the beginning of the Church? We can answer according to the Bible, that the specific moment was after the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ and His ascension to heaven. Specifically, 50 day after his Resurrection on the Pentecost, and starting with the conversion and baptism of more than 3000 people.

So we can say it this way...

<u>Year</u>- 33 A.C. Jesus died when he was around 33 years old. He was baptized when he was around 30 (Luke 3:23), and His ministry lasted around 3 years. According the narrative of the gospels we can see there were 3 Passover celebrations:

1st PASSOVERJOHN. 3:232nd PASSOVERJOHN. 5:13rd PASSOVERJOHN. 18:39

A Parable that can help too is in Luke 13: 6-9.

Place- Jerusalem (Acts 2, Isaiah 2:2-3)

Messengers- Peter and the 12 Apostles (Acts 2:14)

<u>Day</u>- The day of Pentecost (Acts 2:1)

Time- Around 9 am (Acts 2:15)

Topic- The Gospel of Christ (Acts 2:29-36)

Commandment- Repent and be Baptize (Acts 2:38)

Result- The baptism of around 3000 persons that day (Acts 2:41 and 47)

<u>Prophecy Accomplished</u>- The Coming of the Holy Spirit and the establishment of the Church (Daniel 2:44, Isaiah 2:2-3)

>From that moment the Church was established (Acts 2:47). The Kingdom of Christ on earth is His Church (Acts 2:41, 47, Colossians 1:13-14, Colossians 3:11 and Daniel 2:44).

So in few word we can say this about the beginning of the Church:

We want to be the church of Christ, The Church that He bought with His blood (Act 20:28). We don't want to say that we are perfect, but the Church is perfect because Christ is perfect, and the blood that He shed for us is Perfect.

18 For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors, 19 but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect.

1 Peter 1:18-19.

Lets continue sharing the Good news of the Gospel to those who are in a need of a savior, and work together in His Kingdom, The Church of Christ.
