Unbelievers have always had a hard time figuring out the lifestyle of Christ's disciples. When you think about it, you can understand their difficulty. They are guided by a life philosophy that promotes selfishness (the attitude that says, "You've gotta look out for 'Number One'"), a philosophy that models greed ("Take what you can get!"), and a philosophy that assigns

importance in dollar figures (how often have you heard someone ask, "What do you think he's worth?").

Guided by such a philosophy, most folks see people trying to be selfless and generous as "a little different." *Christ-centered people in a self-centered world are difficult to understand*, and some people will never be convinced it could be anything other than an act to gain other's confidence in order to manipulate, exploit, and victimize them.

I mean, try to think about it from their perspective: Why would anybody choose to deny himself or herself of any pleasure —when life is so short?

Why would people whose lives are at least as busy as theirs, carve out time every week for worship, Bible study, and a service project here and there that do nothing to advance their careers? Why would Christians get involved in the lives of those who are poor and sick, and hurting?

See what I mean? People who don't know Jesus have a hard time figuring out why people would behave as Christians do! Our answer would be, of course, that we do these things because we love him. He loved us first. He's done so much for us and continues to do so much for us. The more we understand that, the greater our love for him becomes.

Because we love him, there is nothing we wouldn't do for him. He truly is our everything! I love what William Barclay says, "Love does not neatly calculate the less or the more. It is not concerned to see how little it can decently give. If it gave all it had, if indeed it gave all the world, the gift would still be too little."
