What do we pray about when it comes to our own sin?


What areas of our sinful nature are we putting off, and what qualities of God are we putting on?

"The way you talk and write gives you away."

My dear brothers, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry. James 1:19

The Bible say that we need to be persons that needs to be quick to listen and slow to speak, but normally we do that backwards. It seems to be our nature, but we as Christians need to realize how important is what we say to others, and the way we express things to them. Sometimes the way we talk is not the best way, it's not appropriate for us as Christians.

And after a while came unto him they that stood by, and said to Peter, Surely thou also art one of them; for thy speech betrayeth thee. Then began he to curse and to swear, saying, I know not the man. And immediately the cock crowed. Matthew 26:73-74. Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone. Colossians 4:5-6.

Let's try to show our Christianity in the way we talk. Not only in the way we talk, also what we say, and the way we write, could be offensive to God if we are writing in a bad way. We even need to be careful of what we "post" on the web. All the world sees what we write, and if we are not careful, we could offend somebody. We are "slaves" of what we write and what we post on the web, that's why we need to be really careful, how we express ourselves in the verbal and written way.

And over all, I think that our goal is to please God in the way we think, talk, and write, and in every aspect of our life.


