Thankfulness seems to be a lost art today. There's a story told about a ministerial student in Evanston, Illinois, who was part of a life-saving squad. In 1860, a ship went aground on the shore of Lake Michigan near Evanston, and Edward Spencer waded again and again into the frigid waters to rescue 17 passengers. In the process, his health was permanently damaged. Some years later at his funeral, it was noted that not one of the people he rescued ever thanked him.

The Bible teaches that gratitude is the obedient response of those whose ruined lives have been restored by the Master. Why should every child of God be known for having a grateful attitude over a grumbling attitude? In Luke 17 we see Jesus interacting with ten lepers. Leprosy in Biblical times was a terrible thing. Once a person caught it, it was considered incurable, and those diagnosed with leprosy were banned from society.

Think of how embarrassing that must have been to be a leper. They were disgusted with self; perhaps even angry at God. They were so consumed with the disease that they just thought there was no hope of healing. Because lepers are outsiders, they would be totally dependent on people inside the village to share some basic necessities of life with them and to be merciful to them.

They could have denied their real condition and just put their mind on other things, avoiding their real need and issues. Instead, when Jesus comes their way, they cry out to Him, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!" They understand that without the touch of Jesus upon their lives they are doomed to die and are in desperate need of his mercy and grace!

And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, and fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan. This leper wanted to go and show everyone what had just happened in his life! Yet, he takes time to return to the One who alone made Him whole!

How thankful are you that God's grace is available for ALL people? Do you truly understand more and more of what undeserved grace God has freely poured out into your life...and how are you thanking Him for it?

May we resolve this day to be a grateful (not grumbling) child of God. Have you returned to the feet of Jesus to thank Him for what He's done in your life?

"You received Christ Jesus as Lord. So keep on living in him. Have your roots in him. Build yourselves up in him. Grow strong in what you believe, just as you were taught. Be more thankful than ever before." Colossians 2:6-7

Baptism is Essential for Salvation.

Some religious groups criticize the doctrine of baptism and do not believe it is essential for the salvation of man, but we quote the Apostle Peter in **1 Peter 4:11** "If anyone speaks, he should do it as one speaking the very words of God." And we do, we know and we understand

that we are saved through the grace of God, but that grace demands our obedience. Jesus is the one who explains to us that baptism is necessary and essential for our salvation.

Recently I was driving and saw a sign with the verse from Acts 16:31: "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved-you and your household." The problem is they just quote that verse and try to teach that you just need to believe and you can be saved. We need to continue reading the verses after verse 31, all in context Acts 16:32-34 says, "Then they spoke the word of the Lord to him and to all the others in his house. At that hour of the night the jailer took them and washed their wounds; then immediately he and all his family were baptized." Two words in verse 32 call our attention, "hour" and "immediately". These words show the urgency of the jailer to obey all the Gospel of Christ. Christ teaches in Mark 16:15 -16, He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned"...he said...

Believe + Be Baptized = you will be Saved.

What Christ said is the truth and is what we need to obey. He requests from us obedience through baptism. This is an act of faith and obedience, and if we have the command to be immersed in water, we need to do it.

2 Thess 1:5,6,8-10.

5 All this is evidence that God's judgment is right, and as a result you will be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are suffering. 6 God is just....... 8 He will punish those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. 9 They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might 10 on the day he comes to be glorified in his holy people and to be marveled at among all those who have believed
