Following His resurrection, we are reminded of what mattered most to Jesus now that his work on earth was finished and he was about to hand it over to his followers. He left them with a parting word; the burning thing on his heart which was of greatest importance.

command is given is implied): - "You Go...You Preach". Matthew, in his Gospel puts it like this: "Go...Make disciples."


We hold the answer to life in the Person of Jesus Christ. We commemorate his crucifixion and resurrection everyday. However, I can't help but ask the questions:

- >>To what extent has the resurrection of Christ engaged our total person beyond Easter Sunday?
- >>With whom have we shared the Good News lately the message that there is forgiveness for sins and God's Kingdom is open to you?
- >>To what measure are we speaking to and witnessing about Salvation on a personal level?
- >>Are we finding that our talk and expression of God is often confined to our corporate time on Sunday morning?

Leslie Newbigin, labeled as "one of the leading influences on the theology of mission" was once quoted as saying, "The key focus of the church's mission is not the church but the world." Have we gotten off track? Have we been influenced to compromise the message of Jesus Christ for man-made religious piety?

Have we been guilty of focusing internally instead of externally; more concerned about being coddled than caring for the lost; more intentional about ourselves when it should be about 'them'? Are we well-intentioned and at the same time missing the mark?

The alarming message is clear – church has become a place where people meet for the purpose of attending to personal desires. It is ALL ABOUT ME. This is not what Jesus had in mind, nor is it really the Church. We are only the Church when we pay attention to the personal command, "YOU go...YOU preach". It's sure something to think about!

In John 4:24, our Lord Jesus Christ, in a conversation with the Samaritan woman, teaches her and us a very important principal. This principal is how we are to really worship God; how in this dispensation, this Christian era, we need

to worship God, and He says it very clearly. We need to worship God in Spirit and Truth. How can we understand this? Well, one way to explain this is that we have two aspects of worship...the General aspect and the Specific Aspect.

The first one is the General Aspect. We worship God in some way with every aspect of our life. In our family relationships, if we take good care of our family, then we are pleasing God and in some way we are worshiping Him.

Another example is our jobs. If we work hard, if we are good employees, if we are good bosses, if we do our duties, then in this area we are pleasing God and worshiping Him. These are just two examples of how we worship God in the general aspect of our life.

Let me mention the other, the Specific Aspect of Worship. This is the time when we come together as a group of believers to follow the example of worship we read about in the Bible. We follow the example of Christians in the first century the best way we can. We sing praises to God with our voices, we collect an offering, we partake of the Lord's table, we hear the

Word of God, and we offer prayers to our Lord. This is our specific time of worship that we have on Sundays, following the example left for us in the Bible. There does not need to be a specific place, because wherever a group of believers come together on Sunday, the Lord's Day, and obey the commandments written in the Good Book, that is the primary time of worship; that is our Worship Service. The Word tells us our Lord rose on Sunday and the Lord's Supper and the offering were observed on Sunday. (John 19, Act 20:7, 1 Corinthians 16:1-3) When we come to worship on Sunday we are expressing to our Heavenly Father our desire to have a close communion with Him, through His Son, with the guidance and helping of the Holy Spirit. Let's enjoy our worship experience every Lord's day.
