"But the seed on good soil stands for those with a noble and good heart, who hear the word, retain it, and by persevering produce a crop". (Luke 8:15) In Luke 8:4-15, we read about the sower and the seed parable that Jesus teaches about the human heart: four types of ground or four types of

hearts. God wants to find in us good ground: hearts that receive the Word of God and produce fruit every day. The Christian life is not a seasonal thing. Sometimes in our lives we have "seasons" or period of time when we do certain things like go fishing, play baseball, exercise etc. The Christian life is a way of life and is something you decide to do when you are baptized into Christ, until the last day of your life. Being a Christian is not something that we practice from time to time. Being a Christian means being faithful to God (Revelation 2:10). How is our heart? How is our ground? Are we good ground or are we like the ground close to the wayside, with a hard heart...or like the ground with rocks that believe just for a period of time...or the one that has thorns? God wants good ground. The seed is not the problem, because the seed is perfect; it is the Word of God. This seed is the best seed. The sad thing is that we do not produce fruit like we are supposed to do. Why are we becoming in our society, and in the world in general, so dry, so skeptical, and so unbelieving?

I was studying with someone the other day and I asked this person, "do you believe there is life after death?" His answer was "no". I was shocked, so I tried my best in just a few minutes to show through scripture what Jesus told us about our hope in our eternal life. (Examples: John 14, Luke 16, John 11.) Let's pray to God. He puts in front of us people in Paris with good hearts, with good ground. We need to pray every day and especially for Brent Nichols and John Mark as they are dealing with other cultures. Also for our brothers all around the world .

Every day we have hard work with hearts like we see in Luke 8. It is not easy. How is our ground...how is our heart?
