As a wife of fifty-five years I learned to love my husband and be submissive to him. As a preacher's wife I learned to just be myself and to support my husband.


As a mother and a Memaw I learned to love and care for my three sons, my four grand-children, and my eight great-grandchildren, and be there for them.

Sometimes we talk with people that are not familiar with the topic, "the end of the world," and some find this to be a huge worry. We as Christians do not need to be afraid of this. If somebody has questions about the end of the world and the coming of Christ, we need to be the ones that answer their doubts. We need to be ready

to clarify any questions they may have according to the Scriptures. We, the Church, announce every Sunday that He is coming! When we partake of the Lord's Supper we announce that Jesus will come again. 1 Corinthians 11:26. For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes. The passage says..."until he comes," so in fact we are preaching to the world that the Lord is coming. When we sing songs like "Jesus Is Coming Soon," we announce the end of the world and the coming of Christ. When we pray, we are supposed to be praying that the Lord come soon. Revelation 22:17 The Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let the one who hears say, "Come!" Let the one who is thirsty come; and let the one who wishes take the free gift of the water of life. Revelation 22:17, the Spirit and the wife (the Church) say to the Lord "Come'...and The Lord answers in 22:20, "I'm coming soon!" Revelation 22:20 He who testifies to these things says, "Yes, I am coming soon". And John, who was inspired by God, also says in verse 20. "Amen. Come, Lord Jesus." When we preach to others the Gospel of Christ so they can have the chance to obey the Gospel, we are helping teach the second coming of Christ. Sometimes people have doubts as to why the Lord hasn't come yet. The answer is because He is patient and wants every human to be saved. 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance. Also in verse 14, it says that we need to be doing our duty as we wait for Him. We should not doubt as we wait for Him but instead be sure that He will come! When? We don't know. We just need to be ready!! 14 So then, dear friends, since you are looking forward to this, make every effort to be found spotless, blameless and at peace with him. Are you in Christ? Are you baptized into Christ? Are you ready for the Second coming of our Lord in Glory, so He can take us with Him to heaven for eternity? If not you need to become ready now. 1 Thess 4: 16-18 For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever. Therefore encourage one another with these words.
