Think about this: "Most Christians repent enough to get forgiven, but not enough to see the Kingdom." Now think about what John was saying: "Repent, because the kingdom of heaven has come near!" A modern translation puts it: "Turn to God and change the way you think and act, because the kingdom of heaven is near."

To the Jew of the time, a kingdom of their own was a much sought after dream. Having had their kingdom taken from them and having been under the rule of foreign nations for hundreds of years, their main desire was to be free - free to rule themselves.

John came as an initiator - one who was sent to welcome the arrival of the Kingdom of God. He came with a message much different than the world anticipated. His attire, his ways were so different. He proclaimed the arrival of this life changing event in such a different way. Yet, something about him attracted the multitudes to him. His message, though different, had meaning; his presence, though different, had authority. His message of repentance and the Kingdom of God attracted multitudes to him.

Repentance is incomplete until it envisions His Kingdom. The focus of repentance is to transform our way of thinking until the presence of His Kingdom fills our consciousness.

Matthew 3:8 says: "produce fruit consistent with repentance." The enemy (Satan) attempts to refocus our thinking to this physical realm in order to prevent us from seeing the spiritual realm. Only when we can remove our minds, affections, thoughts and actions from this physical world will we begin to experience the Kingdom life that Jesus came to establish.


Where are you at in this process? Is hidden sin preventing you from experiencing all God has for you? Hidden sin prevents you from having a bold faith necessary to see great things happen.

EKKLESIA

Many years ago I heard a song on tape called, "Water in the Plan." The quartet was The Sound of Glory. I liked the song very much. These words are true, "There is water in the plan of God." In the Old Testament we read of a fountain at the entrance of the tabernacle where the priest washed his body before he came to the Holy place. (Exodus 40:30-32) At the cross when the Roman soldier pierced Jesus with a spear, immediately blood and

water came out. Our Lord was showing a lesson through His death. The blood is for the remission of sins and the water represents the commandment of baptism. (Matthew 28:18-20) The word baptism means immersion; to be buried in water. (Romans 6:3-5) Jesus gave the command to be immersed in water to obey the Gospel of Christ. He is the one who put the rules in the plan of salvation. (Mark 16:15-16). I'm pretty sure if our Lord Jesus Christ gave us other instructions to obey in another way, we would do anything he demanded of us to show him our obedience, but he chose the water in the plan. In obedience, we are to be washed by the water through baptism. Somebody told me on one occasion, "Oh, you see baptism and you see water." I told him, yes, the baptism of the great commission of Christ demands water. (Acts 8:36 & 10:47). In the Bible we find that different kinds of baptism were practiced, however, the only one that brings us to obedience in Christ is the one through immersion in water. ... As they traveled along the road, they came to some water and the eunuch said, "Look, here is water. Why shouldn't I be baptized?"(Acts 8:36) On one occasion, I was talking with a denominational preacher in Mexico who told me, "You don't know anything about baptism; you ignore the different types of baptism that the Bible mentions. At that time I really didn't know much about this topic. That's why I want to share with you, so you won't be caught off guard on this topic.

The Bible teaches around 7 different types of baptism in the Bible:

- 1. **Baptism by fire** (Mt 3:11-12 This baptism is the trials that every Christian suffers.
- 2. **Baptism of suffering** (Mark 10:38-39, Luke 12:50) This is the one that Jesus suffered for us on the cross, and His apostles were willing to suffer too.
- 3. **Baptism for the dead** (1 Cor.15:29)
 (In this text the apostle Paul used sarcasm to prove his point, not meaning that we can be baptized for the persons that are already dead.)
- 4. Baptism of John the Baptist (Acts 19:3)
- 5. **Baptism of the Holy Spirit** (Acts 2:1-4)

this commandment of Christ.

- 6. Baptism in the cloud and the sea (1Cor. 10:2)
- **7. Baptism in the great commission of Jesus** (Matthew 28:18-20 & Mark 16:15-16) This is the baptism we obey because it is the one our Lord teaches us. This Baptism is the only one valid for salvation. The Apostle Paul explained there is only one baptism valid in the Church. (Ephesians 4:5, Acts 2:38, Romans 6:1-6, Colossians 2:12, Galatians 3:27) In all of the New Testament we see the teaching of baptism and the importance of
