

It is easy to find something to criticize—for man has so many imperfections it is impossible for him to hide them all. However, if a person comes to worship, he more than likely will obtain the very thing that brought him there-namely knowing he has been in the presence of God. Jesus made a promise that where two or three are gathered together in His name, He would be there. If a person has come to worship the Lord, more than likely in His sacred quest he will find satisfaction. Analyze your own life. Ask yourself the question, "Have I come to worship, or watch?" You can be successful in both—but only Jim Bill McInteer (1921-2010) Nashville, Tennessee one carries the benefit of blessing.
