to be nice to our siblings during the countdown to Christmas -which wasn't always easy to do!



Luke uses a Greek word describing the anticipation that identifies them as waiting with expectation for the coming of the Messiah, or Savior. It literally means that they were "alert to His appearance, and ready to welcome Him." We see this word in Luke 2:25 in reference to Simeon where we read that *"He was wait-ing..."* and in 2:38 to describe a woman named Anna who was, "*…looking forward to..."*

The best gift we could ever receive is the gift of Jesus himself because we get to unwrap a little each day. As you gather with your family this week, enjoy the time and thank God for the blessing of having each other. Enjoy the exchanging of gifts and thank God for the gift of His Son!
