
"THE BIGGEST WORD?" (by John Gipson)

There are some mighty big words in the dictionary. Take for instance the word, "pneumonoultramicroscopicsilicovolcanoconiosis." It's a word that even my spell-checker doesn't recognize. I'll save you some trouble and tell you that it refers to a lung disease. Even our children have fun with a big word as they sing along with Mary Poppins, "Supercalifragilisticexpialidocious." How's that for a couple of big words? (But don't ask me to spell them again).

It may surprise you, but the word "if" has been called the "biggest word in the language." It stands in front of life's finest possibilities. On a very solemn occasion Jesus even used a double "if" in John 13:17, "If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them."

Man's highest joy and greatest potential is to be found behind the big word "if." In the eighth chapter of Romans we encounter it over and over: "You are in the Spirit if the Spirit of God really dwells in you" (v. 9); "If Christ is in you...your spirits are alive because of righteousness" (v. 10); "If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will give life to your mortal bodies also through his Spirit which dwells in you" (v.11); "If by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body you will live" (v. 13); "If children then heirs, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may be glorified with him" (v. 17); and finally in this chapter, "If God is for us, who is against us?" (v. 31).

What wonderful promises are to be found behind the door of "If." They are there for you and me in Christ. The apostle Paul with joy declares, "Therefore, if any one is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has passed away, behold, the new has come" (2 Cor. 5:17). Is there any brighter day than that?
