BLOOD DRIVE—will be on Wednesday, **August 2nd**. Show up between 4PM and 8PM.



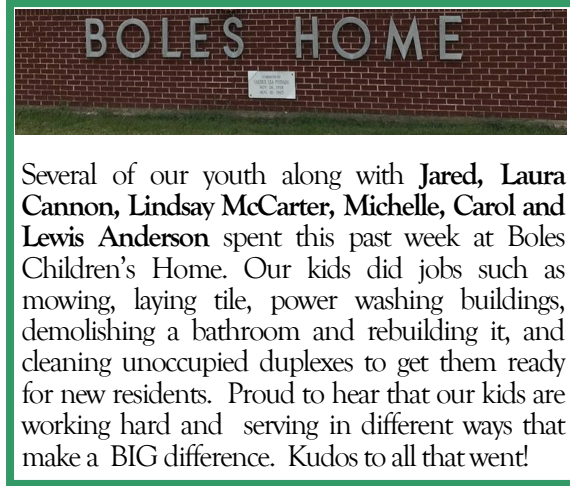
