May we all continue to **PRAY** for this process, which is in the final stretch!

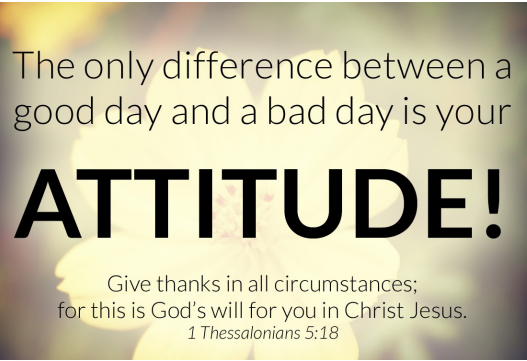
To Our Guests...
